Father’s Day is a holiday honoring fathers, grandfathers, and father figures. In the **United States** and many other countries, it is celebrated annually on the third Sunday of June.

The idea for Father’s Day is often credited to Sonora Smart Dodd of Spokane. In 1908, she wanted to honor her father, William Jackson Smart, a Civil War veteran and widower who raised his six children alone.

The first widely recognized Father’s Day celebration was held in **1910**. In **1966**, Lyndon B. Johnson issued a presidential proclamation recognizing Father’s Day. In **1972**, Richard Nixon signed legislation making Father’s Day a permanent national observance in the USA.

In 2026, Father’s Day in the United States falls on **June 21**, the third Sunday of June.
